The Chaconne series belongs to the mid-to-mid-late flowering group. It features large flowers with thick petals, resulting in excellent vase life. To prevent leaf tip burn and stem breakage, it's recommended to use less fertilizer for the Chaconne series. The White 3, Light Pink 2, and Pink 2 varieties boast particularly strong stems and require ample water for optimal stem height.



L. sinuatum

Sturdy Violet NEW

Extraordinarily early growing, heavy producer and well-suited for winter production, resistant to botrytis. Branches grow upright, creating an excellent shape.





Tanto Pink NEW

Slightly pale pink. This is a highly productive variety that produces a large number of stems from the first flush. It is recommended for summer plantings for the early winter harvesting, the sharply angled branches make it easy to harvest.

Jet Rose NEW

This variety has a reddish rose brush. Brush colour is dark and resistant to colour loss. The uplight branches make it easy to harvest. It is also characterised by its low tendency to brush mis-shape.





Sunday Violet

Standard violet color. Vigorous and easy to grow and manage Produces a large number of branches and rounded bristles. Good workability due to its sharply angled branches. Excessive nitroger can lead to excessive growth and brush disturbance, so fertilise management should be more conservative than usual.

Acute Series

As the series name suggests, the branch formation is very sharply angled and stems extend straight up. Stems rarely become entangled, making harvesting easier.

Prime Violet

Early flowering and suited to winter production. Well branched with small side branches and its strong stems grow vertically. The crop is easy to harvest.



Merry Pink

Easier to grow and maintain volume than other pink varieties. Each voluminous stem features large, sturdy brushes.



Earth Pink

Earth Pink has big calyces which open well. It produces tall and very high quality stems that grow upright and straight into a perfect shape. Crops are easy to harvest and suitable for winter production.



Crystal Yellow

Striking bright lemon yellow cultivar with large, well-formed calyces, suitable for all seasons. Prone to botrytis, so good ventilation and prevention are essential.

Rose Wine

Early flowering, suited for winter forcing cultivation. Wideopening calyces, straight stems. Vivid intense rose color.




Suai Pink

The plant is particularly strong in the pink varieties. You can continue harvesting the large cut flowers during the second and subsequent blooms. The color is a rose-ish pink. Please note that delaying the harvest will turn the brushes blue.



Amethyst Series

Excellent volume with large brushes. Luster Amethyst displays full opened calyces colored with shining bright purple. Lucky Amethyst has dark blue calyces. Their slow growth rate makes them well-suited for summer production.



Pirika Purple NEW 🔏

This variety boasts a striking deep reddish-purple color. It has a good spread, multiple flower buds, and sharp-angled branching that makes harvesting easy. It also has strong fertilizer absorption, so it is recommended to use less fertilizer than usual for base dressing.



Violet Fizz

Large stems with many medium flowers. Summer is the best for growing this late-blooming variety.

Noble Violetta

Intense dark blue brushes, middle to late flowering speed, excellent summer performance, high quality stems.

Dynamic Violet

Intense violet color. Big flowers and thick stems make cut flowers look substantial. Maintains good stem length and branching even in hot climates. Late flowering, suitable for summer production.

Exotic Tall Blue

Middle-late flowering, suited for summer production. Produces high-quality stems and branches during both the first and second flushes. Apply less fertilizer and water as the growth is very vigorous.

Canyon Snow

The calyces fully open, forming well-shaped brushes. Heavy stems and branches grow upright and it is easy to pick them. Among white varieties Canyon Snow is relatively tolerant to Botrytis.

Ever snow is pure white, slender silhouette, excellent for the mixed bouquets. Ever series offers wide range of planting schedule as it does not require much coldness. Ever Rose has the lowest requirement of cold temperature for flower initiation in our red varieties and it allows this variety an advantageous production with high quality flowers.
